



## Yuba College Public Safety P.O.S.T. MODULAR II Application Process

Interested candidate will provide an application with proof of course requirements. Please make sure to review the Course Announcement and Timelines when completing your application. It will be very important to submit a COMPLETE packet to avoid immediate disqualification. The initial packet will require the following items; however, sponsored or affiliated students may bypass certain requirements due to employment/background process:

- Complete a **PelletB Form, Academy Disqualifier & Instructor Verification Form**. Each student must complete the forms located in the 2A Folder for Modular II Application process as soon as possible. Current Yuba College Mod III Cadets do not complete the disqualifier; ALL Mod III Cadets who have not yet graduated will complete the Instructor Verification form. <http://yc-publicsafety.yccd.edu/aoj-forms>

- Complete the Academy Application and attach all supporting documents. **See Task Completion Checklist**. *The Task Completion Checklist will be the cover sheet to your application documents.*
- Complete Modular Academy, Modular II **Application** 1-5 questions.
- POST Profile** <https://www.post.ca.gov/online-post-profile.aspx>
- Possess, without restrictions, a **valid California Driver's License**. Active Duty Military may possess a valid out-of-state driver's license without restrictions.
- DMV Abstract-Copy of your driving record** and license status ("long form") from Department of Motor Vehicles. – FEE Applicable Item
  - DMV Link: [On-Line Request Form](#) [FFDL15 Information Link](#)
  - May not be older than three month (90) days from date of the submission of this application.
- Proof of a **valid car registration** and **auto insurance**. This will be a requirement for the Emergency Vehicle Operations Course (EVOC). All students must be insured drivers.
- Proof of valid **Medical Insurance** (copy of insurance card or coverage)
- Complete the **Emergency Medical Form**
- Proof of **Agency Sponsorship/Affiliation**, *if applicable*.
  - Must be on Agency Letterhead, signed by Chief, Sheriff, Undersheriff or designee.



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- Must state employment title and status
- Must indicate that hiring process has cleared applicant for DOJ. Medical Clearance Requirements will still be required.
- Must indicate sponsorship status:
  - **SPONSORED** – Local law enforcement employee scheduled and paid to attend the academy; wears the agency patch on academy uniform – *Priority Attendance*.
  - **AFFILIATED** – Local law enforcement employee that will receive funding for supplies & equipment and/or adjustment to work schedule to attend the academy; wears the agency patch on academy uniform – *Points received for partial sponsorship*.
  - **ENDORSEMENT** – Law enforcement employee or volunteer in good standing with a recommendation from a department and meets specific criteria; wears the agency patch on academy uniform (will be determined by agency) – *Minimal points received for endorsement*.
- A **PelletB** score will be a required and scored item for ALL students; however, a sponsoring agency can waive the PelletB requirement by stating that in their sponsorship letter. The **SPONSORED** student's score will be an automatic PASS on the criteria score sheet.
- Military Personnel will provide a copy of their **military ID** or a **DD214**.
- Statement of Applicant** Document (read, understand and sign)
- Yuba College Application Process** (*must have a Yuba College Student ID prior to enrollment for the academy*) – FEE Applicable Item (Enrollment)
  - Completing Yuba College Application does not confirm academy attendance
  - Students Attending Yuba College Now – No YC Application will be needed
  - New Students – Application for Admission Can Begin now:  
<http://yc.yccd.edu/admissions/new-students> . You will access the application by completing Step One under 'Apply Now'. Please be advised the application is a 2-step process through CCC Apply. First, you create your CCC ID. A CCC ID is not your student ID number for Yuba College.
  - Complete the Financial Aid (BOGW) to see if you qualify for free tuition
- No felony or misdemeanor convictions in any state or military court that would restrict possession of a firearm** [PC 29800/29805]. Complete a Live Scan fingerprint check through the California Department of Justice to obtain a criminal history clearance for firearms eligibility. **The Live Scan form provided upon acceptance into the program.** – FEE Applicable Item



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- Obtain medical clearance** by a qualified health provider. You will use the Yuba College medical clearance form and have it signed by your provider and returned by deadline date established. **This form provided upon acceptance into the program.** – FEE Applicable Item
  
- Students must provide their own uniforms. **Please make sure to purchase beginning July 17, 2017.** Vendors will need several weeks to make sure orders are received before the academy begins. Prices are estimates ONLY and always subject to change. We currently have three vendors with our clothing requirements:
